The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The meeting was called to order.

The minutes of June 2nd, 2015 were reviewed. A motion was made by Maas and seconded by Hanson to approve the minutes. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Nate Oellien joined the meeting.

Nicholas Johnson discussed the public works hiring recommendation. The hiring committee recommends offering the position to Leon Gehrking. A motion was made by Hanson and seconded by Maas to approve hiring Leon Gehrking to the public works position. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

An agreement between the City and the Minnesota DNR to transfer ownership of a well located south of the swimming pool was reviewed. Public Work staff has no use for the well and it would cost over a thousand dollars to seal. The DNR will use it as a monitoring well. A motion was made by Maas and seconded by Oellien to approve the agreement. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Nicholas Johnson discussed the purchase of a used mosquito fogger from the City of Appleton for \$2,500. A motion was made by Oellien and seconded by Hanson to purchase the sprayer from Appleton upon satisfactory inspection. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.
